WHAT'S ACCEPTED

ACCEPTED: Controlled Substances, schedule II-V • Prescription and over-the-counter pills and capsules • Liquid medications, including ointments, lotions, and creams (in sealed containers, please!) • Veterinary medications • Vitamins, supplements, homeopathic remedies • Medical patches • Inhalers (empty) • Medical samples

NOT ACCEPTED: Needles/sharps/EpiPens • Schedule I Controlled Substances (examples: LSD, heroin) • Cannabis (medical or recreational) • Illegal drugs • IV bags • Bloody or infectious waste • Personal care products (body lotion, shampoo, etc.) • Aerosol cans • Thermometers or medical devices

NATIONAL PRESCRIPTION DRUG TAKE BACK DAYS

Dispose of medications, including controlled substances, at special one-day collection events sponsored by the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA).

HOW TO PREPARE

HOW TO USE DROP-OFF LOCATIONS

- Remove pills from containers and pour into a resealable plastic bag.
- Black out personal information.
- Recycle empty pill containers at home.

HOW TO USE THE MAIL-BACK ENVELOPES **M**

- Pick up a free mail-back envelope at participating locations.
- Fill the envelope with up to 8 oz. of pharmaceutical waste.
- Take sealed envelope to any United States Postal Service mailbox.
