



## FOOD SERVICE WARE ALTERNATIVES

### REUSABLE IS BEST



Single-use plates, cups, and cutlery may seem economical and convenient, but replacing these items with reusable alternatives can **reduce product and disposal costs, minimize waste, and attract new customers.**

Use this calculator to determine your break-even point for the cost of reusable items. The break-even point is the number of uses required to recover your investment. As soon as you exceed the break-even point for a particular item, you'll be saving money. Restaurants report a minimal increase in water costs needed to run dishwashers.

**Cost of reusable (each) = \$\_\_\_ ÷ Cost of disposable item (each) = \$\_\_\_ , so break-even point = \_\_\_ uses**

Example: Reusable cup = \$1.00 each ÷ Disposable cup = \$0.05 each, so break-even point = 20 uses

### Limited funding is available through the Zero Waste Sonoma Reusable Foodware Grant

- Food & beverage providers may receive up to a \$300 reimbursement for eligible reusable foodware expenditures.
- Purchases made through this grant are to be used by the entity at the place of business/service within Sonoma County.
- A W-9 and receipt(s) are required, and entities must provide a description of how the reusable foodware items will be used.

### FIBER COMPOSTABLE IS GREAT



Products made entirely from uncoated paper or plant fibers are accepted in the residential and commercial green container within Sonoma County as they break down easily in a commercial composting facility or in a backyard compost pile. Note that **compostable plastics such as those made from polylactic acid (PLA) are not accepted** in the green container for a variety of reasons.

Please refer to the Supplier List below to purchase uncoated paper products for your food/beverage establishment.

#### Fiber compostable

- Uncoated white / natural plant fiber paper plates, boats, clamshells, cups, utensils, straws
- Uncoated white / natural deli wrap and parchment paper
- Paper napkins
- 100% wood, bamboo or palm leaf utensils, plates, boats, bowls
- **Biodegradable Products Institute (BPI) [www.bpiworld.org/](http://www.bpiworld.org/)** is America's leading certifier of compostable products and packaging. Only unlined and uncoated fiber products certified by BPI should be used. This certification ensures no intentionally added PFAS chemicals.

**BPI certified unlined and uncoated fiber or other third party certified products or are preferred.**

**Products with intentionally added fluorinated chemicals (PFAS) are prohibited.**



## FOOD SERVICE WARE ALTERNATIVES

### RECYCLABLE IS GREAT



**Recyclables** The following items should be clean and empty:

- Plastic drinking cups and containers larger than 4" in diameter
- Plastic clamshells or other to-go containers
- Aluminum trays and to-go containers
- PET #1\* and HDPE #2\* plastic items are preferred over #3- #6 plastics, as they are the easiest to recycle

\*Postconsumer recycled content products support manufacturers using recyclables collected through curbside or commercial pickup and require less virgin plastic to produce.

### NOT ACCEPTED

**Compostable plant/bio-plastic products** (Not accepted by the local composting facilities.)

- Coated paper or fiber food containers (If it has a shiny surface, it is likely coated in plastic or PLA, which is marketed as "compostable")
- Plastic or "compostable" bioplastic utensils



**Products with intentionally added fluorinated chemicals (PFAS) are prohibited.**

**Selected plastics** (these items are not recycled by haulers in Sonoma County.)

- Polystyrene foam (Styrofoam)
- Utensils
- Plastic wrap
- Straws (may be provided only upon request to consumers with medical needs)



**If an item is not recyclable or compostable at local facilities, it must be sent to the landfill.**

Exemptions will be allowed for disposable hot beverage cups, as there are no truly compostable or recyclable products available at this time.
