A Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) is planned to be added to the Central Disposal Site Transfer Station building. Its operations are expected to be consistent with its existing listing in the NDFE. The existing composting site at the Central Disposal Site is scheduled to be closed by October 15, 2015. A new compost facility sited at the Central Disposal Site is undergoing evaluation and preparation for permitting is expected to begin Summer or Fall 2015. The new compost site is expected to need a new entry in the NDFE.
